**Absence** - If your child is absent from school, please contact the school office before 9.00 and give a reason for the absence.

**Meals & Snacks** – At break time, fruit is provided for children in Ash class.

Children in Ash class (Years R, 1 and 2) are entitled to Universal Infant Free School Meals.

Children may bring a healthy packed lunch from home if they prefer. No fizzy drinks or glass bottles are permitted. All children are able to refill their water bottle with fresh water during the day.

**Parking** - Parents are asked to park their cars responsibly and not directly outside school.

**Transport** – We encourage children to walk to school, or travel by scooter or bicycle, wearing a helmet.

**Uniform** – All children are expected to wear the correct school uniform including appropriate footwear during the school day

and for P.E. lessons. Please help us by labelling clothes and all personal property.

**Behaviour** – We encourage a positive approach to behaviour based on success, praise and reward. We ask parents to contact us with any circumstances at home or school they feel may affect their child's behaviour or performance in school.

**Emergency Closure** – In the event of severe weather or other unforeseen circumstances, it may be necessary to close the school at short notice. Please check the school website, the County Council website, or listen to local radio stations.

**Absence Requests** – We are unable to authorise term time holiday requests.

**Collective Worship** – Children take part in daily acts of worship.

**St. Mary's Church** – Children visit our Parish Church several times a year for a service often based around a Christian Festival. Parents and community members are welcome to join us at these services.

**PTA (FOWS)** - Please help us to raise money for the benefit of the children and to strengthen the relationship between families and the school.

The PTA funds a range of activities and projects, e.g. Ash class outdoor classroom and storage, the Christmas pantomime, pupil laptops, transport for trips, various equipment, books at Christmas and Easter treats. We also support regular events such as Sports Day, May Day and special days which have seen the children experience a wide variety of cultural, sporting, musical and practical activities to enhance the

curriculum.
