Year 3 & 4 Residential Trip – Woodlands Outdoor Centre Monday 27th March to Wednesday 29th March 2023

Next year our Year 3 and 4 children are invited to visit an Outdoor Education Centre in Woodlands near Glasbury on Wye. More information on the centre can be found on their website

The cost of the residential, which includes three days full board and lodging, transport and insurance, is £210 per child.

To enable your child to take part in the residential visit, please complete the permission and payment of a £75 deposit via ParentPay (Tackley) or SchoolMoney (Wootton) by **Friday 30th September 2022**. We will hold a meeting for parents and children nearer to the visit. The school must confirm the booking as soon as possible and need to know if there will be sufficient children taking part in order for the residential visit to go ahead. We would like all Year 3 and 4 children to take part if possible. If you need any further information or have any concerns, please let me know.

Parents are asked to pay for the trip by instalments, as follows:

£75 deposit by Friday 30 th September 2022	£27 instalment by Friday 16 th December 2022
£27 instalment by Friday 21 st October 2022	£27 instalment by Friday 20 th January 2023
£27 instalment by Friday 18 th November 2022	£27 balance by Friday 24 th February 2023

Please can I ask you to ensure each instalment is paid by ParentPay (Tackley) or SchoolMoney (Wootton), reminders for payments will be sent to you nearer the time.

Woodlands Outdoor Centre offers a residential visit which provides value for money while ensuring that your children have an enjoyable and safe experience. If your child is eligible for free school meals or pupil premium please speak to the school office to enquire about a reduction in the cost for this trip. Oxfordshire Outdoor Centres also benefit from the Dave Thorne Bursary scheme which aims to help children and young people needing financial subsidy to attend outdoor education activities with their peers so if you have any concerns regarding affordability, please contact your relevant school office.

Please note that if you decide to withdraw your child from the Woodlands residential and we cannot fill the place, your deposit cannot be returned and you will be liable for the full amount.
